

MINUTES OF HIGHLAND CITY COUNCIL MEETING**Monday, November 19, 2007**

The meeting was called to order as a special session to canvass the results of the 2007 Municipal Election at 5:00 p.m., and notice of the time, place, and agenda had been provided the *Deseret Morning News*, *Daily Herald*, *Salt Lake Tribune*, and *Lone Peak Press* November 14, 2007.

1. Canvass of 2007 Municipal Election

City Recorder Wini Jensen presented the results of the 2007 Municipal Election which were received from the Utah County Elections Office. (A copy is attached to the minutes.) Mayor Franson acknowledged the following who received the highest vote and who will be seated on the City Council: Kathryn S. Schramm, Brian W Braithwaite, and Larry M. Mendenhall. He noted the voter turn-out was 51.48%.

Motion: Brian Brunson moved to accept the tabulation for the municipal election returns for the 2007 Municipal Election. Motion was seconded by Glen Vawdrey, and it passed by unanimous vote.

Mayor Franson acknowledged appreciation to the Council, and specifically to those who ran for office. He felt a lot of progress has been made in doing the people's work. He also expressed appreciation for the professionalism with the campaign and felt individuals did an outstanding job conducting the campaign. Kathryn Schramm indicated she would miss serving with the two Council members who were not re-elected, specifically Glen Vawdrey and Steve King.

Wini Jensen inquired when the Mayor would want to swear in the new City Council. Mayor Franson set Wednesday, January 2, 2008, and the remaining meeting schedule for January will be adjusted for the City Council and Planning Commission meetings. Gina Peterson will

prepare a calendar for the dates City Council Meetings will be held for 2008.
