The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. The meeting was called as a work session, and notice of the time, place, and agenda had been provided the *Deseret News*, *Daily Herald*, *Salt Lake Tribune*, and *New Utah* on April 10, 2006.

### **1. Work Session on Street Lighting/Dark Skies Ordinance**

Matt Shipp made a presentation on street lights which are being used in the City. He reported presently the City has 65 of the new poles and 219 between the wood poles and fiber glass poles. He further indicated he wanted direction from the City Council on a policy for street lighting and indicated in the past lights have gone in at intersections and at the end of cul-de-sacs. As subdivisions have gone in fiber glass poles were installed. The new pole design is being placed in some subdivisions. He indicated he is getting from 5-10 calls per week from people inquiring about street lights.

Kathryn Schramm indicated she had been approached about providing a light at 9600 North and the Alpine Highway as it would tell people there is an intersection in which they could turn west.

Mayor Franson indicated he would pick a couple of Council members to work with Matt Shipp to bring back a recommendation. Steve King and Kathryn Schramm volunteered to serve on the street lighting committee. The City Council generally favored less lighting, than more lighting. Barry Edwards suggested the Council find some volunteers to serve on the committee.
